## How to complete Baromedical Nurses Association Experience Log for New CHRN candidates

**Date:** the only acceptable format for date is month, date and year, i.e., 1/22/2020. One entry per day.

It is NOT acceptable to report as a weekly or monthly total.

**HBO Hours:** This column is for hours actually participating in HBO dives, i.e., chamber operator, inside Attendant. This number should be listed for example: 90 minutes must be reported as 1.5 hours.

**Complication:** this is for reporting events you might have experienced during your time in the chamber Environment. It is optional and can be reported as the name of the event, i.e., seizure, ear block

**Hours in Pre Dive Preparation:** This is time spent teaching patients about HBO in advance of their dive. It may include time spent getting vital signs and clearing patient for dive. This should be reported for example: if you spend 15 minutes prepping for dive, report .25 hours for that patient.

These hours should be reported for the total time for the day, i.e., four patients at 15 minutes should be reported as 1 hour of prep time.

## Fire Drill – Ventilator patients and in Chamber TCOM - Check if date applies.

**Notes:** this is for your use to include any information you would want the BNACB to know about that days experience.
